LEGAL NOTICE
The North Carolina Clean Water Bond Act of 1971, as amended, required that public notice be given of receipt of each eligible application for a State grant from funds allotted for use in the various counties of the State to aid in financing the cost of construction of water supply system projects.

The Division of Health Services has received an application from the County of Perquimans for a State grant under the North Carolina

Clean Water Bond Act of 1971. The application seeks a grant of \$120,000 from funds allocated for use in Perquimans County and \$925,750 from funds allocated for Statewide use. This grant would be applied as a portion of the construction cost of a water supply system project. The proposed project will consist of construction of two 200 gallon per minute wells, a treatment plant, two elevated water storage tanks; one of 300,000 gallon capacity and the other 250,000 gallons; and distribution quantities as follows: 31,600 linear feet of 8 inch PVC pipe, 460,480 LF of 4 inch, 184,800 LF of 4 inch, 36,760 LF of 3 inch, 138 valves, 12 meters, 30 hydrants, 1,500 services and 2,000 LF of miscellaneous casings.

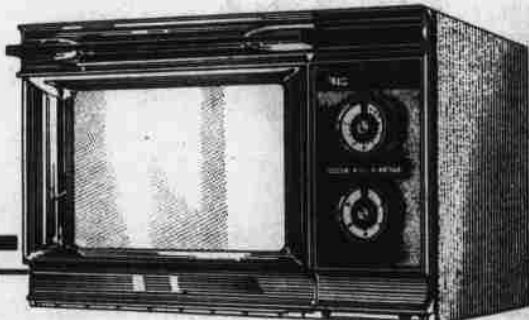
