Bits Of Interest For Our Readers

The "Fourth of July Bargain Sale" was founded by Ezra Beetle in celebration of Independence Day. In 1776, Ezra owned a small general store outside Boston. When word reached him on July 2 that the Colonies had agreed on a Declaration of Independence, he recognized a golden opportunity at hand. He could get rid of all the junk that had been accumulating in his store. Ezra immediately took out an advertisement in the Boston paper with a blazing headline: "Beetle Has Gone

Crazy - he is selling \$15 horsewhips for \$2.95..." He later wrote his brother, "Long after the Declaration of Independence is forgotten, the people of America will remember the Fourth of July as an occasion when the American businessman sacrificed his merchandise in the spirit of patriotism...Not only was started an American revolution, but a business revolution and thanks to Ezra Beetle, it has never been the same again."
