## Court Related Seminar Planned

A seminar for court personnel and child-serving agencies in the First Judicial District is being planned to be held in the Pasquotank County Courthouse in Elizabeth City on Wednesday, May 4. The purpose of this seminar is to inform persons working in child serving agencies such as schools, social services, vocational rehabilitation, mental health, court counselors, clerks of court, county attorneys, and interested persons about the changes in laws affecting juveniles and about when legal recourse is the proper alternative to be taken. This seminar is being

planned as a result of interest voiced by the Pasquotank County House Bill 456 Task Force, which studied local needs as related to delinquency prevention programs and alternatives to training school commitments.

The Honorable G. Grafton Beaman, District Court Judge, will speak on procedures applicable to children in the jurisdiction of the district court. Assisting him with planning of this seminar are Mrs. Jo Ann Morris, District Court Counselor, and Mrs. Jo Ann Forman, Office for Children Field Consultant.
