

"What's even more important," Mrs. Campen con-tinued, "is that this is not a give away welfare program. **Most Food Stamp recipients** pay for their stamps. The program is used to stretch the food dollar to insure good nutrition, and most of the elderly on fixed incomes really need the extra food the program can provide to
