Jump Rope-Is Returning

WASHINGTON - Jumping rope, once a children's game confined to playgrounds and sidewalks, has ecome fashionable.

Nonsense rhymes of childhood have been eplaced by wheezing gasps exertion as Americans work to bring down their weight and build up their stamina by skipping rope, the National Geographic Society says.

EVERYBODY'S TRYING

Now it seems as though everyone from actresses and airline pilots to welders and truck drivers is hopping inside a whirling loop as jump ropes move from tyms to back yards and basements - wherever there's enough room to avoid snagging the furniture.

Trainers long have known that jumping rope regularly can increase a boxer's endurance. Today, basketball stars, tennis players, and other athletes are taking up the activity to keep in condition

Jumping rope is touted as a way to improve coordination, burn off some excess calories, replace fat with juscle, and strengthen the cardiovascular system. But eters warn it can put une stress upon the heart if verdone.

It also can cause aching hins, sore joints, and ackaches - unless the imper wears soft-soled boes, bends the knees, and jumps just high enough to clear the rope.

Fans, however, insist that

a 10-minute workout with a rope is equal to half an hour of jogging, and said one: "You don't have to go out in the rain and dodge traffic."

Adherents cite other advantages to jumping rope: It can be done in private, requires little space and even less cash outlay, and is portable. The director of a health club in Los Angeles notes that "the jump rope fits easily in a suitcase."

MODELS GETTING FANCIER

But as jumping rope has become popular, manufac-turers have rushed into the market with fancier ropes. A purloined length of clothesline or a piece of No. 10 window sash cord no longer suffices.

Instead, jump ropes come with wood or plastic handles, some with roller bearings, and at least one with a digital counter. The rope itself may be three-ply cotton, nylon or other synthetic yarns, or even leather.

For faster turning, one firm makes jump ropes in loops like a pliable chain to reduce wind resistance. The ropes also are available in bright hues and colorful stripes, but these can sometimes be hazardous.

An American visitor to Northern Ireland a few years ago reached for her jump rope only to have it jammed back into her handbag by her alarmed escort.

"Do you want to get us killed?" he asked. Pointing to its red, white, and blue pattern, he warned: "People will think you're asking their children to jump to the colors of the British flag."

time for colds and flu and sneezes. But there are some diseases and accidents that do their worst in hot weather.

Some of these are obvious. Sun strokes and heat strokes are more likely to occur in July and August than in January. Too much exposure and too much exer-cise in the hot sun may produce sun stroke. Prolonged excessive heat, either in or out of doors, can cause heat stroke. In either case it is important to keep the victim cool and call a physician at

Sunburn has hospitalized many a vacationer. Everyone should know, says the American Medical Association, that gradual exposure to the sun, beginning with a few minutes a day, is the recommended course. But many of us forget to watch the clock and to take precautions against sunburn in the excitement of the first day at camp or at the seashore.

The bacteria that cause diarrhea and stomach upsets multiply much faster in lukewarm foods, and it's important to keep cold foods

in refrigeration and to keep hot foods hot.

Swimming is fine exercise and also is good for cooling off on a hot day. Those with sinus or ear trouble should be careful about swimming. Swimmers should make certain that the water is safe from pollution. A clear mountain stream may look attractive. It also may be loaded with germs. And there still are cases of typhoid and disentery from drinking untreated water. Campers can disinfect water by boiling or by commercial disinfectant tablets.

If there are horses or cows around, there is likely to be tetanus. Tetanus (lockjaw) is very serious. It can be prevented by injection of tetanus toxoid. If your family hasn't had tetanus boosters recently, get your shots before going to the country.

Flies, roaches, mosquitoes and ticks are troublesome in the hot months. Insecticides and screens usually can keep them under control. In tick country it is important to make a close examination after disrobing and remove




