NC senators in the news

WASHINGTON, D.C. —
Senator Robert Morgan
(D-NC) has received the
'Watchdog of the
Treasury' Award from the
National Association of
Businessmen, Inc. The
award was given for his
voting record in the
present session of Congress
to reduce what the Association
labeled 'wasteful
spending.'

In a special ceremony,
Morgan was presented the
award by NAB Chairman,
Arthur T. Roth who said,
'The people of North
Carolina are fortunate to
be represented in the
Senate by a member whose
concern with inflation and
excessive government
spending is reflected in his
voting record.'

NAB, a nonpartisan
organization, has been
rating members of Con-
gress on their voting
record since 1964. The
rating was based on 10 key
votes taken during the
session.
