Machinery Act of 1971, GS. 105-308, Duty to list; penalt

Every person in whose name any property is to be listed under the terms of this sub-chapter shall list the property with the tax supervisor or proper list taker within the time allowed by law on an abstract setting forth the information required by this sub-chapter.

In addition to all other penalties prescribed by law, any person whose duty it is to list any property who willfully falls or retuses to list the same within the time prescribed by low shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment not to exceed six months. The failure to list shall be prime facile evidence that the failure was willful.

Any person who removes or conceals property for to purpose of evading taxation or who aides or abets the removal or concealment of property for the purpose of evaditaxation shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by fine not to exceed tive hundred dollars (\$500.00) or impronment not to exceed six months.
