**FARM MARKET SUMMARY WEEK OF APRIL 9-13, 1979**  
 NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE DIVISION OF MARKETING  
 A total of 17,014 feeder pigs were sold on 12 state graded sales during week of April 9, according to the Market News Service of the North Carolina Department of Agriculture. Prices were largely \$2.45 to \$3.00 lower per hundred on 40 to 70 pound pigs. US 1-2 pigs weighing 40-50 pounds averaged \$100.75 per hundred pounds with No. 3s \$95.27, 50-60 pound 1-2s averaged \$89.30, No. 3s \$80.29, 70-80 pound 1-2s \$77.43 per hundred pounds with No. 3s \$68.61.  
 Corn prices were 3 to 4 cents per bushel higher and soybeans 13 to 15 cents lower through Thursday, April 12, compared to the same period of the previous week. No. 2 yellow shelled corn ranged mostly \$2.45 to \$2.74 in the Eastern part of the state and \$2.70 to \$2.75 in the Piedmont. No. 1 yellow soybeans ranged mostly \$7.33 to \$7.64 in the East and \$7.15 to \$7.40 in the Piedmont. No. 2 red winter wheat \$3.50 to \$3.80; No. 2 red oats \$1.11 to \$1.16 per bushel and milo \$3. to \$4.25 per hundred. New crop prices quoted for harvest delivery corn \$2.50 to \$2.56, soybeans \$6.74 to \$6.90, Wheat \$3.02 to \$3.15, oats \$1.12 to \$1.16.
