Bleak X-mas for poor

Even with help on the way in January for fuel bills, this will still be a bleak Christmas for most of North Carolina's approximately 800,000 poor residents, according to Robert H. Ward, director of the Division of Social Services of the N.C. Department of Human Resources.

"With incomes already below the poverty level and the continued erosion of these meager incomes by inflation, I am afraid our state's poor are in for a long cold winter and not a very bright holiday season," Ward said.

He indicated that if it had not been for the tremendous voluntary effort of the state's more fortunate citizens during the past Christmas seasons, these occasions would have also been bleak.

"Churches, organizations and individuals have shown great concern for our state's poor during past Christmas seasons. But with inflation continuing to gnaw away at these very limited incomes, I urge everyone to dig a little deeper this year to share with the poor. I urge this realizing

January 11, 1980, and then be publicly opened and read for the construction of a water-based recreational development. This development is located adjacent to the Perquimans River in the town of Hertford, Perquimans County, North Carolina.

The estimated quantities of the major items of work are:

1. Bid Schedule I (Site B): 176 sq. yds. boat ramp; 12,500 sq. ft. trailer parking area; 136 lin. ft. boat docks.

2. Bid Schedule II (Site A): 1 job pier deck and wood piles; 1 job restroom facilities; 1 job picnic shelter.

3. Bid Schedule III (Electrical): 1 job wiring restrooms and fixtures installed; 18 each lighting fixtures; 1,250 lin. ft. underground wiring.

One contract will be awarded for each of the above listed bid schedules. Bidders are invited to submit bids for Schedule I, II, or III any combination thereof.

The estimated price range for each of the bid schedules is \$10,000 to \$150,000.

The bid security in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total bid price must be submitted with each bid less than \$25,000. Bids in excess of \$25,000 must be accompanied by bid security in an amount of not less than twenty percent (20%) of the amount bid.

Security may be in the form of a bid bond, cashier's or certified check, postal money order or cash.

The successful bidder will be required to execute a formal contract. If the bid exceeds \$10,000, a performance and payment bond, each in the amount of 100% of the total amount of the contract, must be furnished.

A contract will not be awarded to a firm in which any official of the sponsoring local organization, the contracting local organization, or any member of such official's immediate family has direct or indirect interest in the pecuniary profits or contracts of such firm.

All work listed for bid Schedule I shall be completed within 102 calendar days after the date of receipt of notice to proceed. All work listed for bid schedules II and III shall be completed within 210 calendar days after the date of receipt of notice to proceed.
