

Veeco increase won't affect EMC

The \$18.4 million rate increase, which went into effect on Jan. 14 to Veeco's wholesale customers, should not mean an increase in the rates Albemarle EMC members pay, according to Ed Brown, Jr., general manager of the electric cooperative.

"If Veeco's projections are anywhere close to being correct, the increase in base rates to bring North Anna No. 2 Nuclear Station on line should be more than offset by the savings in fossil fuel charges reflecting the cheaper cost of nuclear power," said Brown.

Some \$11.9 million of the wholesale increase applies only to electric cooperative customers like Albemarle EMC. The balance of the increase will apply to various municipal systems in North Carolina and Virginia.

Brown said the increase amounted to 10.3 percent in the rate base paid to Veeco mainly in increased demand charges to the company. He added, however, that fuel savings of \$19.6 million are expected to result in net savings of \$7.7 million or 6.5 percent.

"These figures are based solely on Veeco's projections and are not our own," Brown stated. "Naturally, for the projections to become a reality at the very least the North Anna Unit must stay on line and not experience the problems that have plagued the Surry Nuclear Units," he added.

Brown said that the cooperative had no plans to increase rates to members based on Veeco's rate filing and that any savings would flow through to the members.
