### Farm ponds provide enjoyment and recreation in N.C.

Farm ponds provide hundreds of hours of enjoyment to North Carolinians each year. Both young people and old take pleasure in an afternoon of fishing. While ponds can provide water for stock or for irrigation, fishing is their primary

There are over 67,000 ponds in our state. These are either embankment ponds (with dams) or the dug type. In eastern North Carolina there are mostly the dug pond kind, since the water table is usually high enough to

ill the pond.

After a pond is constructed it should be stocked with fish. The usual stocking is of bass and bream. These two species provide a good balance. The bream are stocked in the fall and bass are introduced the following summer.

Fish for stocking are provided at no charge to any pond owner. Although this program has a chance of being eliminated by government officials, applications for stocking are still being taken. These can be obtained at your local Soil Conservation Service office. Stocking rates for the fish are 500 bream and

50 bass per surface acre of water. This 10 to 1 ratio keeps the fish population in proper balance.


A yearly maintenance program is necessary for good fish production. Fertilizer can be appliced from February to October at a rate of 100 pounds of 8-8-2 per acre. Repeat this application at a 7-10 day interval until the color of the water prevents the sight of a white object held 12 to 18 inches below the surface. Liming is also required. It is one of the most overlooked parts of a good pond management program. Water ph's from 7.0 to 9.0 are best suited for fish. Most of our dug ponds are too acidic for good fish production. Lime should be applied at a rate of at least one ton per acre per year or until correct ph levels are reached.

Fishery biologists say the biggest problem with farm ponds is that they are under-fished. Ponds can easily become overstocked with small byream if these fish are not removed. Fishing them out is the best way to do this. The bass however, should not be removed until after about a years

Areas around ponds should not be left bare. Spoil dirt from dug ponds should be spread and seeded to grass. This material is acidic and requires liming. It should not be allowed to wash back into the pond, where it can make the water acidic and murror. Grassed areas around the pour edge also act as filtering systems remove sediment and chemicals, addition, it makes the pond most

Many people will be around far ponds when warm weather arrive. Safety cannot be over emphasing. There should be some type of like saving devices located around the pond. Long poles or flotation device should be available to reach someone who gets into the water. Most pond owners discourage swimming, because someone can accidentally fall in. Dug ponds are usually very

Ponds should be a source of enjoyment to their owners and by proper management they can be just that
