Roebuck, owner of the 11-store S &

R supermarket chain in four area counties, was appionted to the board in 1977, by the Pasquotank County Board of Commissioners. He has taken an active interest in the growth of the community college which serves seven Albemarle area counties in northeastern North Carolina

In 1982, through the COA Foundation, he established a \$75,000 trust fund to provide scholarships for nursing students in commemoration of his late wife, Carrie M. Roebuck. He has served as an executive director of the foundation since its inception in October of 1981.
