# Sunday School lesson-

A New Day For God's People Isaiah 2:24; 62:1-3

With today's lesson we begin a series of studies in the book of Isaiah, which will continue through February. It should prove to be a very interesting series of studies for many reasons. Primarily, Isaiah belongs at the head of all lists of the Prophets.

In him prophecy reaches its perfection. H. I. Nester (Heart of Hebrew History) likewise states that "the book of Isaiah stands at the head of all books of prophecy. It is noblest in prophetic literature of all the Old Testament."

Isaiah served as God's prophet to Judah during the years extending from 750 to 698 B.C. He stood firm against idolatry and every other sin which threatened the Kingdom during his years. In today's lesson we shall see him as he announces "a new
