nouncement. The Title III grant of ECSU funds program activitles in ECSU funds areas: (1) computer and information sciences; (2) academic computer developm system; (3) career cement of administrative
puting: puting; (5) strengthening commanagement; and (5) Title iis coordination.
It also calls for the full application of Computer Assisted Instruction to
all academic areas, so that students

will attain essential computer iteraey skills prior to completing their undergraduate studies. Initially, under direction of a Computer Center Manager and an Academic Computing Committee, 12
faculty members will be trained. faculty members will be trained.
Once trained, these will be used to help train the next group, as the Academic Computer Support System is expanded.
Through upgrading of the current Microdata System, ECSU also seeks computing capabilities.

Because of increased student
demand, ECSU had demand, ECSU had earlier been authorized and assisted by General North Carolina system, in making preliminary plans for development of the program. According to Dr. Sohindar S. Sachdev, Chairman of the Mathematics Department, 80 students, mostly
mathematics majors mathematics majors, are con-
centrating in computer science centrating in computer science,
while over 300 students are taking computer science courses. A Curriculum Developer and a Computer Technician will be hired
immediately to work with ECSU administrators in purchasing and
installing 40 microcomputers and necessary software; test the new system and make expanded connections with TUCC: prepare a plan
for modificatin and/or renovation of facilities that will house the comfacilites that will house the com-
puter hardware; develop courses for the new major; secure necessary reference books that will support course development; and provide faculty and staff training.
ECSU's plans, supported by Tite IIl funds, go far beyond development of the degree program in computer
