## Elizabeth City State University awarded Title III Grant

Dr. Jimmy R. Jenkins, Chancellor, announces that Elizabeth City State University has been awarded a \$414,973 Title III grant for the 1983-84 academic year. The grant, made possible under provisions of the U. S. Office of Education's Special Needs Program, represents the first year's allocation for a program funded for five years.

"Because of the impact this grant will have on our present and long range plans, and the indirect impact it will have on northeastern North Carolina, we certainly take this opportunity to commend James E. Swimpson, title III Coordinator, for guiding the proposal from its inception, through revisions and fruitful negotiating sessions," Dr.

Jenkins noted in making the announcement.

The Title III grant of ECSU funds program activities in the following areas: (1) computer and information sciences; (2) academic computer support system; (3) career development program; (4) enhancement of administrative computing; (5) strengthening fiscal management; and (6) Title III coordination.

It also calls for the full application of Computer Assisted Instruction to all academic areas, so that students

will attain essential computer literacy skills prior to completing their undergraduate studies.

Initially, under direction of a Computer Center Manager and an Academic Computing Committee, 12 faculty members will be trained. Once trained, these will be used to help train the next group, as the Academic Computer Support System is expanded.

Through upgrading of the current Microdata System, ECSU also seeks to enhance its administrative computing capabilities.

Because of increased student demand, ECSU had earlier been authorized and assisted by General Administration of the University of North Carolina system, in making preliminary plans for development of the program.

According to Dr. Sohindar S. Sachdev, Chairman of the Mathematics Department, 80 students, mostly mathematics majors, are concentrating in computer science, while over 300 students are taking computer science courses.

A Curriculum Developer and a Computer Technician will be hired immediately to work with ECSU

administrators in purchasing and installing 40 microcomputers and necessary software; test the new system and make expanded connections with TUCC; prepare a plan for modification and/or renovation of facilities that will house the computer hardware; develop courses for the new major; secure necessary reference books that will support course development; and provide faculty and staff training.

ECSU's plans, supported by Title III funds, go far beyond development of the degree program in computer and Information Sciences.
