NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special bond election will be held in the County of Perquimans, North Carolina, on May 8, 1984, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said County the questions whether they shall approve or disapprove (1) the indebtedness to be incurred by the issuance of bonds of said County of the maximum principal amount of \$2,000,000, which indebtedness shall be secured by a pledge of the

County's faith and credit, and (2) the levy of a tax for the payment of such bonds, and (3) the bond order entitled, "BOND ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$2,000,000 SCHOOL BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF PERQUIMANS," adopted by the Board of Commissioners of said County on March 5, 1984, to authorize the issuance of said bonds and the levy of such tax.

The \$2,000,000 School Bonds are authorized to pay capital costs of providing school facilities in Perquimans County, including the construction and reconstruction of school buildings, plants and other facilities, the acquisition of necessary land or rights-in-land and the acquisition and installation of furnishings and equipment necessary for such school facilities, for the maintenance of public schools in the County for the school term prescribed by law.

The ballots to be used at said election shall contain the words, "SHALL the order authorizing \$2,000,000 of bonds secured by a pledge of the faith and credit of the County of Perquimans to pay capital costs of providing school facilities in Perquimans County, including the construction and reconstruction of school buildings, plants and other facilities, the acquisition of necessary land or rights-in-land and the acquisition and installation of furnishings and equipment necessary for such school facilities, for the maintenance of public schools in the County for the school term prescribed by law, and a tax to be levied for the payment thereof, be approved?", with squares labeled "YES" and "NO" beneath or beside such words in which squares the voter may record his choice.

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In the event a majority of the qualified voters voting at said election vote to approve the order, the incurring of indebtedness and the levy of a tax related thereto, said bonds shall be issued and taxes shall be levied for the payment of such bonds.
