Sportsmanship award: male - Wayne Corpew; female - Cindy Eure.

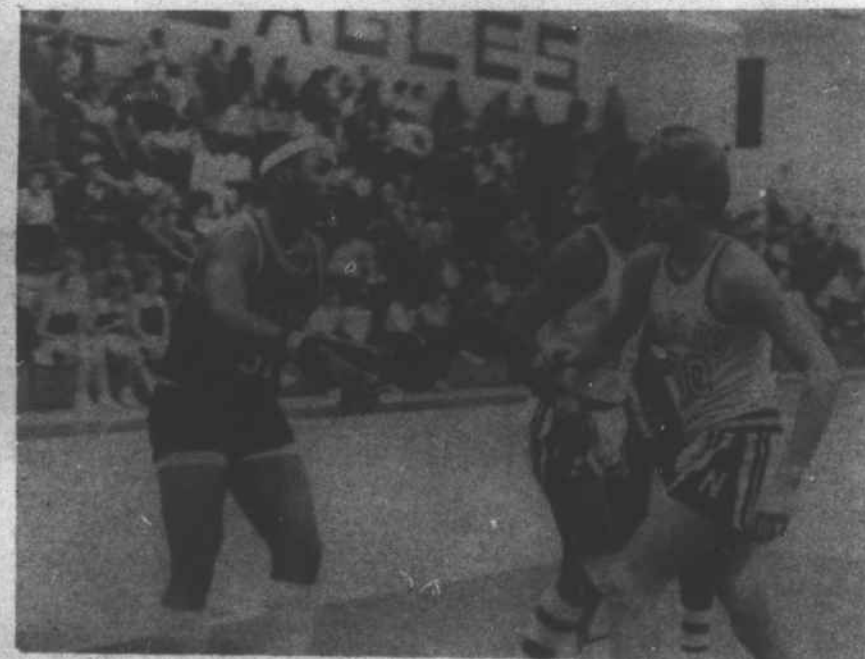
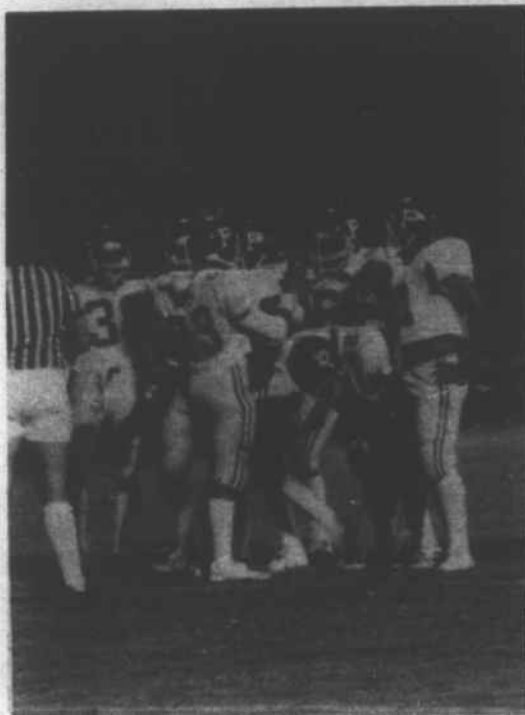
