## "Peachy" treats for indulging dessert lovers

Perhaps you are the lucky one who has peaches stored away in the freezer, or canned and on the

crusts

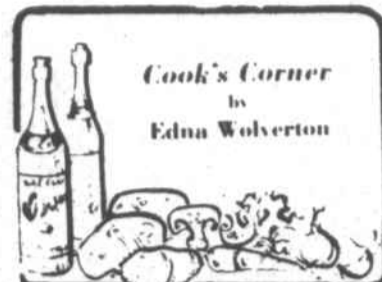
made with peaches. Actually the frozen pie can be made with strawberries but the peaches are the best! Save these recipes for the summer months and enjoy when the fruit is fresh and in season. But tempt yourself now if you have the fruit available.

Combine the fruit, sugar, vanilla and milk. Fold in the whipped topping. Pour the mixture into two crumb crusts. Refrigerate in the freezer. Thaw (a little) at room temperature prior to serving. Yield: two pies.

½ tsp. vanilla or almond extract

Split the ladyfingers and place on the bottom and sides of a small Pyrex dish or ice tray. Sprinkle with enough brandy to moisten them well, but do not soak them.

Place the peaches over the ladyfingers. Whip the cream and add the extract and sugar to taste. Pour over the peaches and freeze until firm, several hours or overnight. Remove from the freezer 20 minutes before serving.
