Chicken is a stopel in my 1/2 cup finely diced onion kitchen. The versitile bird presents an almost limitless list of possible preparations. Enjoy these two variations. The Country Captain and Teriyaki Chicken are both delicious served with buttered rice. Add a tossed salad and bread to complete the meal.



COUNTRY CAPTAIN 1 3-pound frying chicken one-third cup flour 1 teaspoon salt 1/4 teaspoon black pepper 1/4 cup butter

1/2 cup finely diced green pepper 1 clove garlic, minced 11/2 teaspoons curry powder

1/2 teaspoon dried thyme 2 cups canned stewed tomatoes 3 tablespoons dried currants

1/4 cup blanched toasted almonds Cut the chicken into serving pieces; wash and dry them thoroughly, and coat them with a mixture of the flour, salt, and

Heat the butter in a large skillet and brown the chicken. Remove the chicken and add the onion, green pepper, garlic, curry powder, thyme, and the stewed tomatoes to the skillet. Stir to loosen the browned particles on the bottom of the skillet.

Return the chicken to the skillet, cover, and cook slowly 25-30 minutes or until tender. Stir the currants into the sauce and garnish with the toasted almonds.

TERIYAKI CHICKEN

1 3-31/2 pound chicken, split or cut into serving pieces ¼ cup sake or sherry

1/4 cup oil

¼ cup soy sauce 1 clove garlic, crushed 1 teaspoon ground ginger

1-11/2 tablespoons sesame seeds Mix the sake or sherry, oil, soy

Serve the chicken with boiled sauce, garlic, and ginger. Pour rice and chutney. over the chicken and marinate for 2 hours. Turn the chicken over occasionally during this period to keep the pieces well coated with the marinade.

> Broil 5-6 inches from the flame, basting frequently with the marinade and turning the chicken every 5-10 minutes. When almost done, dip each piece of chicken in the marinade, roll thoroughly in


