National Vocational Education Week observed in schools

Each year during National Vocational Education Week, the Perquimans County Schools Vocational Department has displayed and exhibited students' work. Vocational Education

Week will be observed February 12-15, 1986. "This year more than ever we need to exhibit Student Work and inform the general

public how vocational tax dollars are spent," stated Kenneth L. Stalls, director of Vocational Education for Perquimans County Schools.

Student exhibits, activities and practical demonstrations will be conducted in the Southgate Mall, in Elizabeth City, beginning on Wednesday, February 12, through 6:00 p.m. Saturday, February 15.

Stalls also outlined the offerings in the Perquimans County Schools, which include Business and Office Education, with a model program in Computer Science, Automotive Mechanics, Home Economics, Industrial Arts, Agriculture, Welding, Drafting and a Occupational Explorational Program in the junior high school.

The purpose of the Fair is to inform the general public of extensive and comprehensive vocational programs in the schools offered to students that desire and need vocational training in order to continue their education or compete in the labor market.

The Theme of the Exhibit is, Vocation Education—"Learning a living." Approximately 35 projects will be on display representing approximately 10 counties.
