

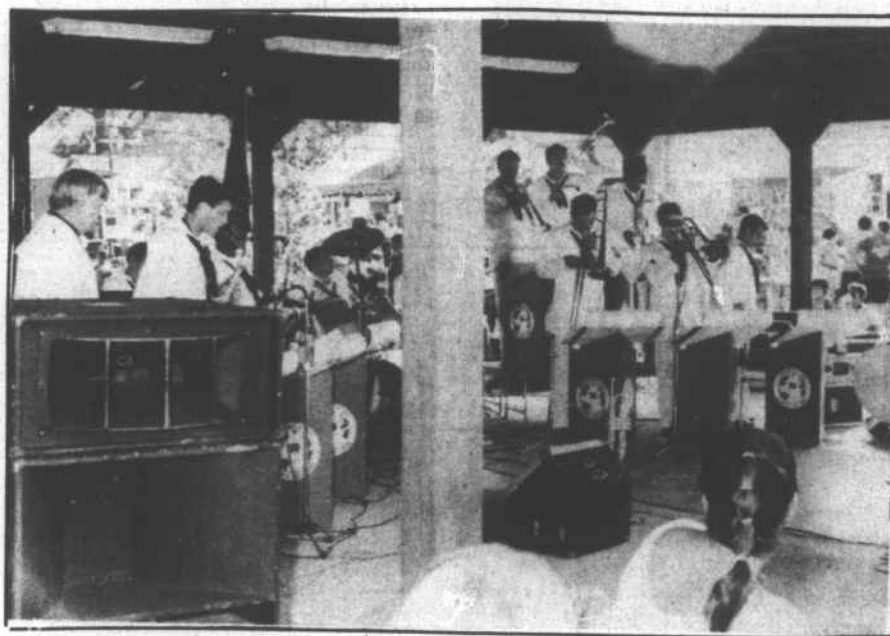
# Indian Summers Festival
