## Sweet potato recipes to enjoy concentrate and pineapple. Mix well.

Sweet potatoes are apart of our fall harvest. Enjoy a tasty pudding, or try these stuffed sweet potatoes as a nice accompaniment for roast pork. TIPSY SWEET POTATO PUDDING

34 cup sugar

- 2 cups raw sweet potatoes, grated (about 2 potatoes)
- 12-ounce can evaporated milk 1/2 cup milk
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon ground nutr eg 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup shredded sweetened coconut 4 tablespoons butter, melted
- 2 tablespoons Jack Daniel's whiskey Whipped cream as garnish

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Generously butter a 11/2 quart casserole
