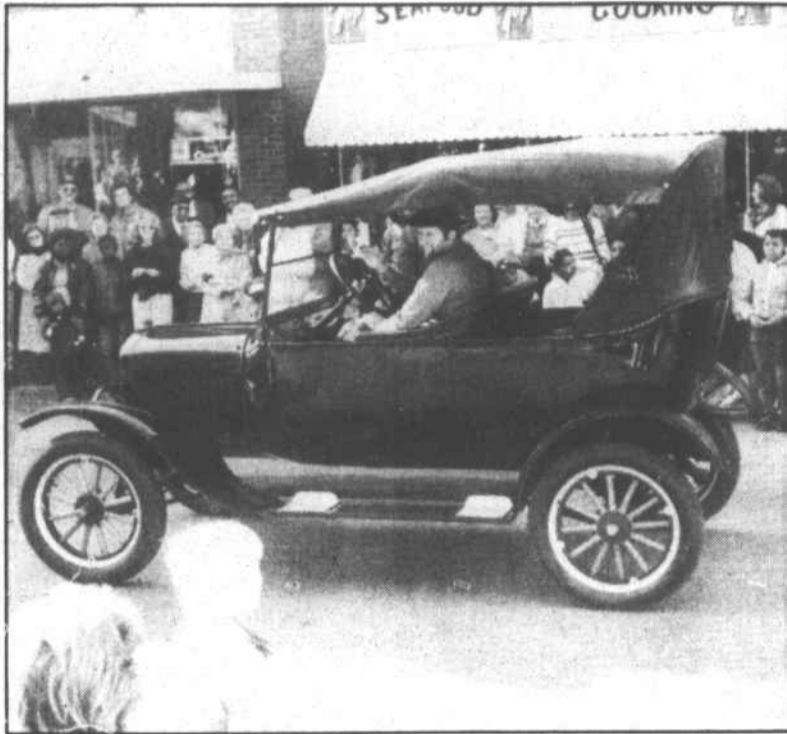
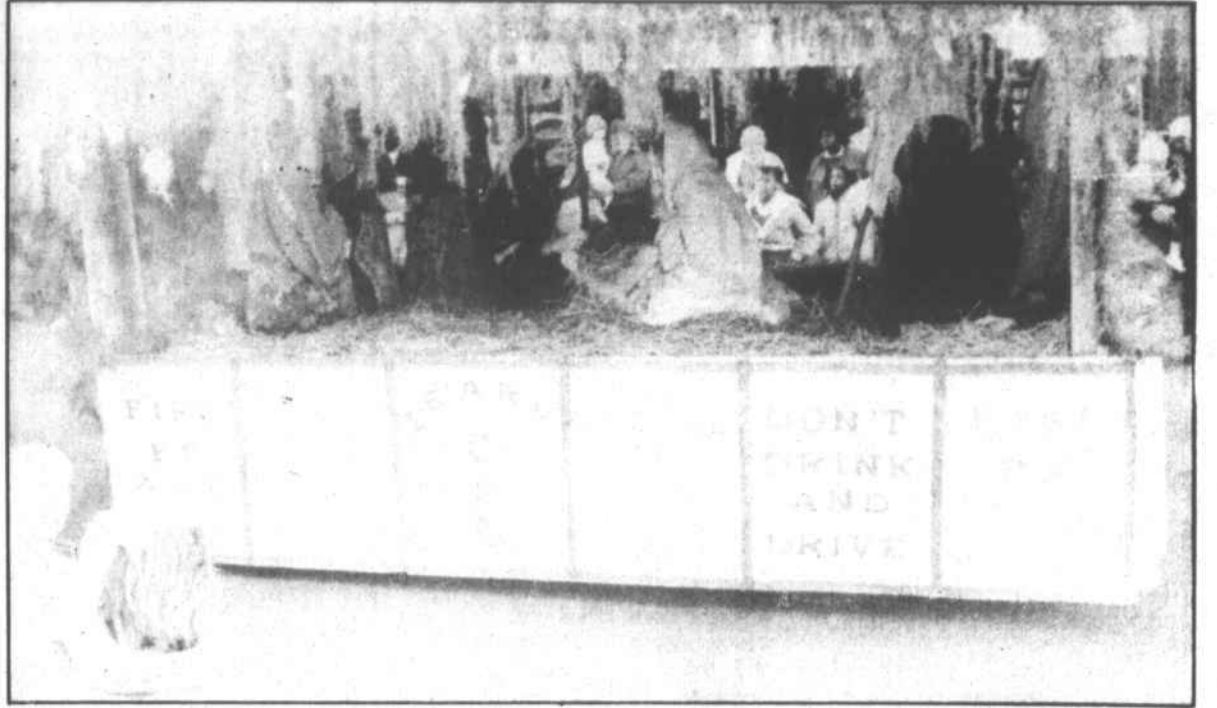


Highlights of the 1986 Christmas Parade

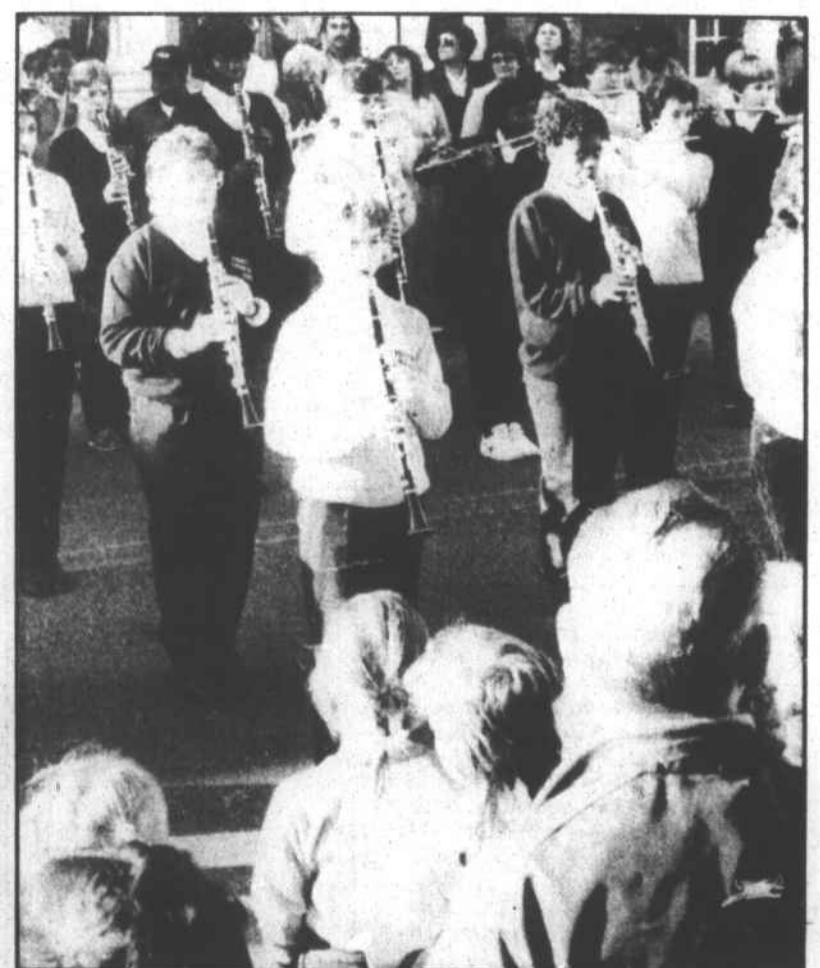
After the parade everyone went to Missing Mill park for a concert, and the dedication of a new flag pole to the citizens of Perquimans County.
