Barber also won an academic award for completing all program requirements and demonstrating outstanding academic performance.

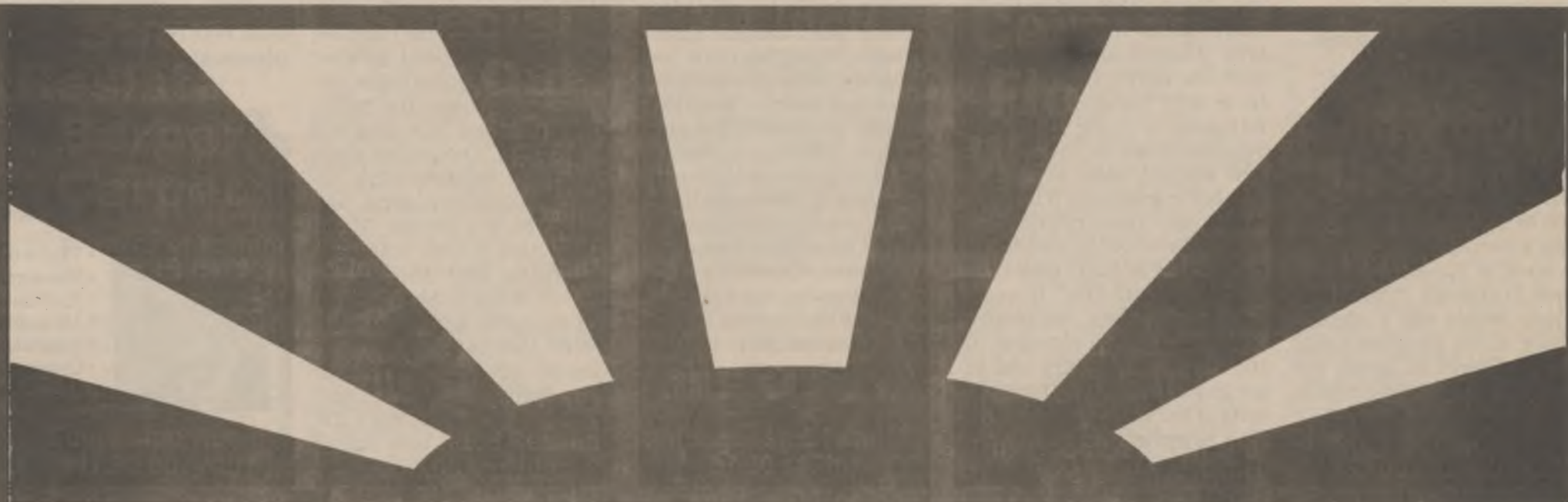
COA offers HRD classes
