Friends and relatives are invited to attend.



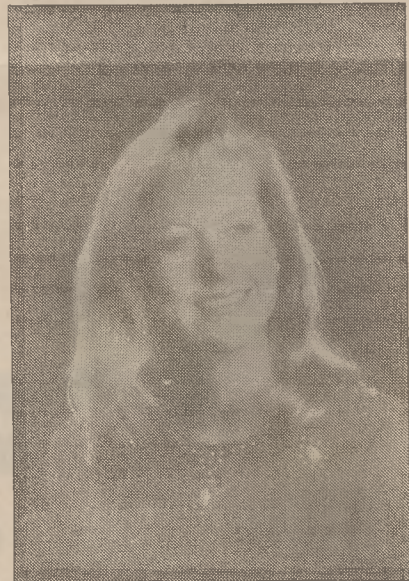

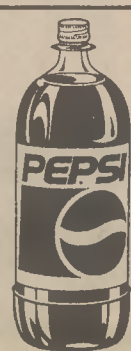

Graduation exercises were held recently at the Perquimans Learning Center for 11 participants successfully completing the "Eating Right is Basic 2" series.

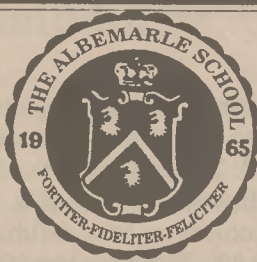
Earline White, Nutrition Program Assistant, gave a review of the program.
