Consumers can now get free credit reports

North Carolina consumers can request their free annual credit report from the three nationwide consumer reporting companies — Equifax, Experian and TransUnion.

The Fair and Accurate Credit Transactions Act of 2003 (FACTA) amends the Fair Credit Reporting Act (FCRA) and requires the nationwide credit bureaus to provide consumers a free copy of their credit report, at their request, once every 12 months.

The three companies have set up one central Web site, toll-free telephone number, and mailing address through which consumers can order their free credit report. To order, consumers should click on www.annualcreditreport.com, call 1-877-322-8228, or complete the Annual Credit Report Request Form and mail it to: Annual Credit Report Request Service, P.O. Box 105281, Atlanta, GA 30348-5281.

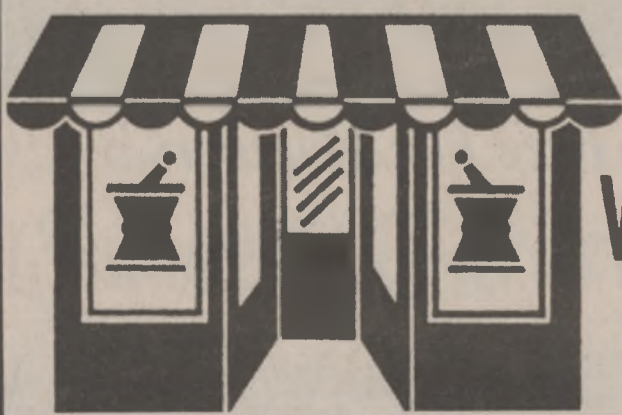
