"We would like to find out what the community would like the arts league to be and how a community arts center could help to revitalize the downtown area," Corr said.

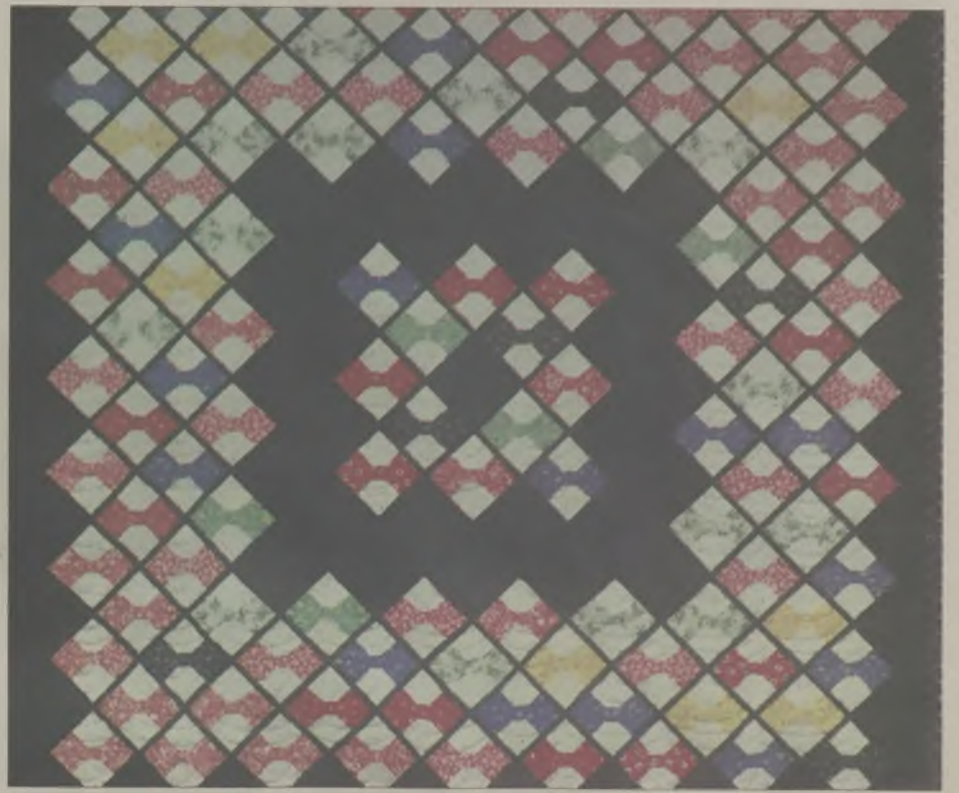
# Cancer program Oct. 14

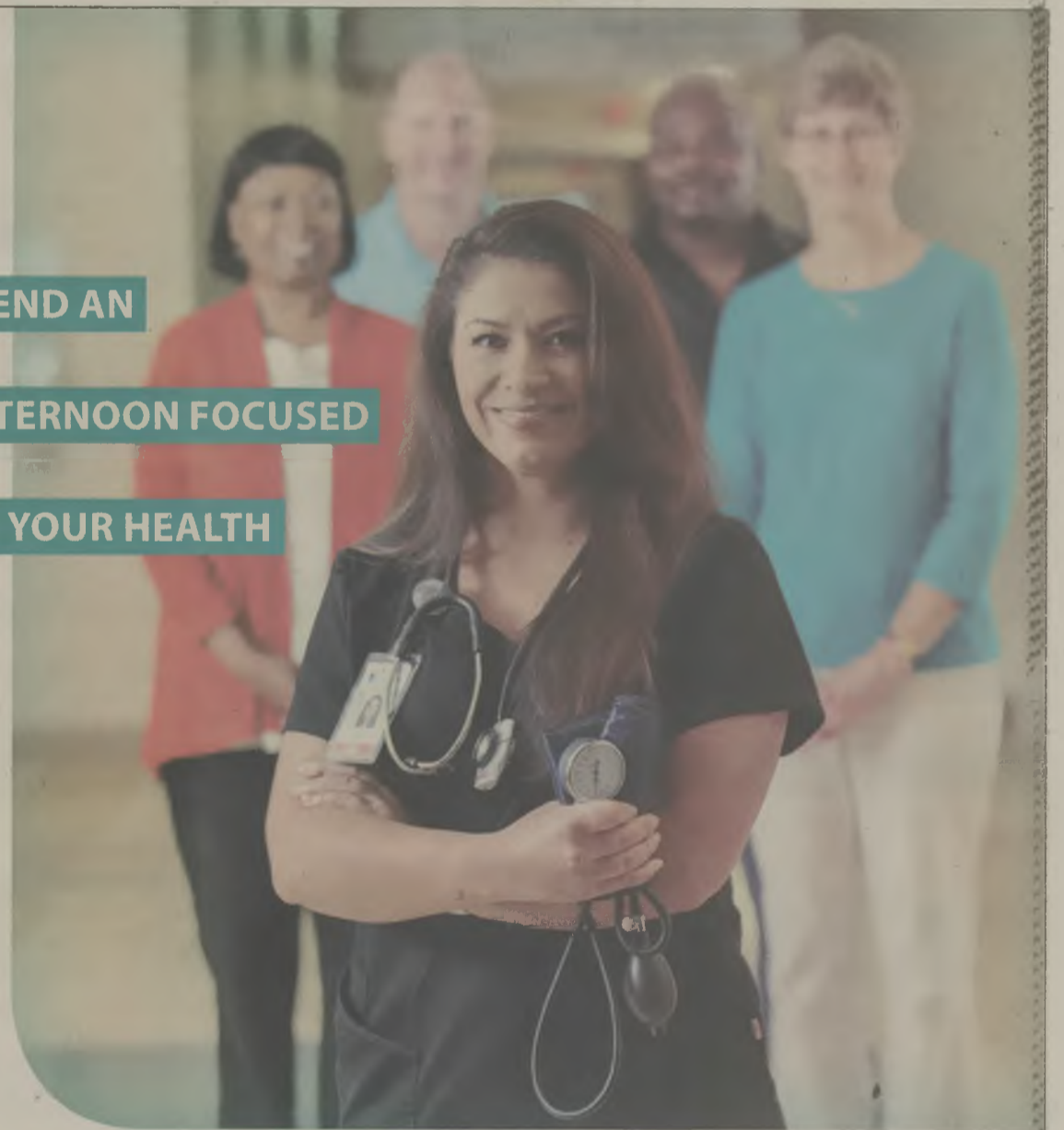

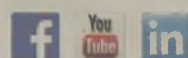
