# Man injured in one car accident

#### From Staff Reports

A 31-year-old Perquimans County man was in fair condition at a Virginia hospital Saturday after authorities said his vehicle left the roadway and ended up in a ditch.

Paul Ritter, of the 500 block of White Hat Road, was traveling north on New Hope Road when his 2013 Chevrolet Spark left the roadway, state Trooper C.Q. Anderson said.

Perquimans emergency management officials said the first reports of the accident came in at 6:36 a.m. and that firefighters from and didn't see any skid Durants Neck and Inter-County volunteer departments as well as Perquimans sheriff's deputies responded.

Eure said the man would regain consciousness before blacking out again. Eure said the man was transported to Sentara Norfolk General Hospital by helicopter. A Sentara Norfolk General spokeswoman confirmed Ritter was in fair condition there.

Anderson said Ritter was wearing his seat belt prior to the accident. The trooper said he found little damage to Ritter's vehicle marks or tire tracks. The speed limit in the vicinity of the accident is 55 mph, Anderson said.
