Albemarle Regional Health Services has announced the October schedule for the Perquimans County Health Department.

The health department is open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. On Thursdays a night clinic is available until 7 p.m.

There is a fee, based on income, for most clinics. Immunizations and general clinics are held every day and other clinics are by appointment only. Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD)

and other communicable disease services are free. Appointments for STD services may be required.

## THE POWER OF PRAYER MATTHEW 6:6 (NRSV)

**“But whenever you pray, go into your room and shut the door and pray to your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you.”**
