He has also served as the captain of the Pirates for the last three years. He is also a volunteer firefighter. He spends many hours serving others through this volunteer service coupled with learning essential on the job skills for firefighting. He is enrolled in the Fire Tech Academy and in the EMT classes offered at the high school. Worley plans to attend a four-year college upon his graduation in 2017.
