This is an ideal condition that can never be hoped for. But the honest people of North Carolina, who have no concern in the bickerings and strife among petty political factions, can and should demand that all these be treated alike. That the district attorney who is charged with paying \$2 a day for board and charging the government \$4 should be made to answer just the same as 25 cents for a dinner and charges the government 35 cents; and it should be ascertained whether Federal judges, as was shown in the case of Swain of Florida, are charging, or have charged, the full amount allowed them-\$10 a day-for expenses when they actually paid only a fraction of this amount The report went abroad after the Swain trial that some of the judges were so alarmed that they covered back into the Treasury amounts collected in this way.
