The California Wine association recently sent to Stockton a barge load of wine saved from its cellars on Fourth and Brannan streets, in San Francisco, which will be distilled into brandy. The wine was pumped from the cellar of the burned storage place into the barge, which holds 250,000 gallons, and was towed to Stockton by a steam tank carsiand conveyed to the El Pinal winery.

A fire brigade is now being used to pump out the wine in the San Francisco cellar and it is run through 2,000 feet of pipe to the foot of Third street, where it is loaded into tanks. About one and a half million gallons of wine will be saved in this manner.
