"Prayer is the soul's sincere desire, unuttered or expressed; The motion of a hidden fire, that trembles in the breast." Amos 4:12: "Therefore thus will I do unto thee, O Israel: and because I will do this unto thee, PREPARE to meet thy God, O Israel." Ezra 9:9: "For we were bondmen; yet our God hath not forsaken us in our bondage, but hath extended mercy unto us in the sight of the Kings of Persia, to give us a reviving, to set up the house of God, and to REPAIR the desolations thereof, and to give us a wall in Judah and in Jerusalem." Isa. 58:12: "And They That Shall Be of Thee shall build the old waste places; thou shalt raise up the foundations of many generations; and thou shalt be called, The REPAIRER of the breach, The RESTORER of paths to swell in." The bible is full of urges to Prayer. When Israel had lost favor with God, they were given the most striking - yet simple direction for deliverance in 2 Chronicles 7:14, "If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves and pray, and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I Hear from Heaven and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land." Prayers are like wrenches, they are all the same in purpose, but they differ in plans, and operative objectives. Some wrenches can be used only on bolts of the same dimension or measurements. This, reminds me of canned or written prayers, or formal petitions. Prayers from prayer books. . . but, there is the "Monkey Wrench", and the "Stillson". . . they can be used for bolts of any size, as the need may demand. So the real prayer, like that of the publican in the temple; Peter when sinking, and the dying thief. In order that we might climax this message with an exhortation to prayer, let us take up the two major operations of personal and united prayer, contained in our subject: PREPARE and REPAIR. First, let us think how prayer prepares: Prayer does not change God, but it does change the individual who prays. The petitioner is affected more than the petitioned. Prayer prepares the heart, by making it humble, pure and sincere. Prepares the mind with wisdom and understanding. Prepares the spirit, with submission to the spirit of God. Prepares the body, making it wholly acceptable unto God. Prepares the eyes, that they may see good in others, and spy sin at a distance. . . Also, to see the hand of God in the scheme of things, and be lifted up to the hill from whence help cometh. Prepares the ears, that they may hear what the spirit saith. Prepares the tongue, to confess His goodness, proclaim His love, and sing His praise. Prepares the hands, for willing service. Prepares the feet, to walk the narrow way, and run on errands of mercy. Prepares a Church, "So that the gates of hell cannot prevail against it." Prepares a city, to escape impending doom. Prepares a nation, to be exalted by righteousness.</p>
