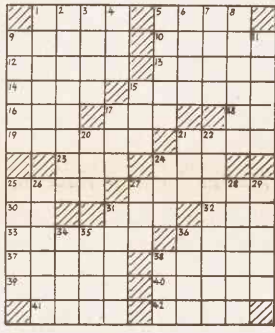
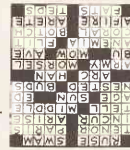

arbitration. The agreement calls for merit rating panels of two rather than three members, as before. "The simple reason is it should be much easier to schedule meetings with only two rather than three people involved," Love said. Should two panel members disagree over the qualifications of an individual, a third member

can be brought in. Grievances over a panel's rating would be processed through the new grievance procedure. Moreover, multiple grievances over the same matter can now be processed jointly. The Department has also agreed to stipulate in job posting if a position requires travel in excess of 10 percent of working time.
