first detected in the United States in the early 1900s by a doctor in the midwest who was treating a chronically ill West Indian student. Since that time, it has been stated, and usually accepted, that one Black American in ten (1 in 10) is born with sickle cell trait (the carrier state for Sickle Cell Anemia) and that one American in five hundred (1 in 500) is born with the disease (Sickle Cell Anemia).

Sickle Cell Anemia is an inherited disease and cannot be contacted or caught by personal contacts or associations. You are born with the trait or the disease or you will never have either. Sickle Cell Trait (the carrier state for the disease) will never develop into Sickle Cell Anemia and Sickle Cell Trait is NOT a mild form of the disease, Rumph stated.

There is no cure for Sickle Cell Anemia and our screening process is not geared so much to detecting Sickle Cell Anemia as it is to identifying those individuals with Sickle Cell Trait. Persons found to be carriers for Sickle Cell Anemia are given a short intense course the form of genetic counseling, as to their chances of producing off-springs with the major said. 




