S. Miller, chairman of the department of nursing, The University first began to offer a four year program, leading to licensure as a registered nurse (R.N.) as well as to the bachelor of science degree in nursing, in 1969. Prior to that year the school had enrolled only nurses holding the R.N. license, offering them a bachelor's degree program. Temporary accreditation has been accorded the school since the program began. The graduation of the first

four-year class in 1973 saw full accreditation, for an eight-year period, extended by the National League for Nursing. Currently the department of Nursing enrolls 183 students, with 11 full-time and four-part time teachers. The department will admit 75 freshmen in the fall of 1975, and that class has been filled since February 1. The 1975 graduating class will be the third since the new program began.

Rolark, the association's present president, has announced that black women in the pursuit of law activities throughout the United States have been invited to attend the conference, being held at the Statter-Hilton Hotel. "There are fewer than 600 black women attorneys in the United States," Attorney Rolark noted in her announcement. "It is, therefore, the determination of NABWA to identify with young black women who are preparing to enter the field of law." The association has invited conference participation of students of law and para-professionals.

A feature of the Friday - thru - Sunday sessions will include a banquet address by D.C. Superior Court Judge Margaret A. Haywood on

Saturday evening, April 5. A variety of workshop sessions are scheduled among which will be little and Edelin cases, Communications Law from the Black Perspective and Women and Discrimination in Housing. Other sessions will include attention to Present and Continuing Problems in Black Admissions to the Bar, Discrimination in Employment, the Black Female Offender Juvenile Delinquency - child Abuse - Child Neglect and Consumer Product Safety Laws and You. Dean Marquis Delarmon of the North Carolina Central Law School, Dr. Rosa Clausell, a child psychologist; Dr. Alice Gullatte, a psychiatrist; and Ken Holbert, deputy director of the Civil Rights Division of

the federal Department of Housing and Urban Development, Barbara Williams Executive Director, Congressional Black Caucus. Brenda Irons of the Federal Communications Commission; Savannah Potter, deputy public defender, New Brunswick, New Jersey, Program Chairman and A. Lillian Kennedy-Chase, Washington, D.C. banquet chairman.

Besides Mrs. Rolark, national officers of NABWA are Vice President Barbara Sims, professor of law at the State University of New York at Buffalo; Jean Capers, Secretary, who is a special assistant to the Attorney General of Ohio, and Florida State Rep. Gwen Cherry, treasurer.
