forget that O.J. was a member of two world record teams at Southern Cal."

Owens won four gold medals at the Olympics in Berlin in 1936. Also 1975 will mark the 35th anniversary date for Owens having won six events and set four World at the big Ten championship meet in 1935.

Some of the top athletes from Pan Africa expected to participate in the meet includes Charles Asaiti in the 400 meters, John Kipkugat and Mike Boit in the 800 meters, Filbert Bayi in the 1500 meters and John Aki-Bua in the 400 meter hurdles.

The men and women teams of the USA - Pan africa and West Germany will meet in an historic International Triangular Competition. It will be the first competition between teams of Pan-Africa and West Germany and also the first appearance of a West Germany track and field team in the USA. USA - West Germany have competed in Stuttgart, Augsburg and Munich, Germany.

Approximately 45 men from each team will compete in a twenty-event program over two days of finals. Approximately 20 women from each team will compete in a 15 event program. There will be two competitors from each team and all running events will be contested in meters except the 4 x 100 and 4 x 400 Relays.

In addition to a tremendous battle for the team championship based on the great strength of the Pan-African team from the 400 meters to 10,000 meters and the field event strength of the West

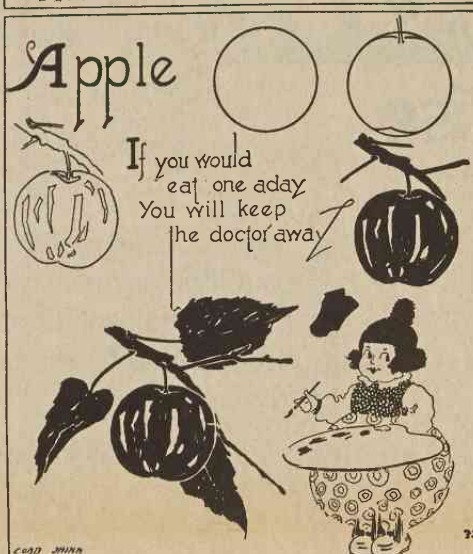
The airman is a 1973 graduate of East Forsyth High School and has studied at Gifford Technical Institute in Greensboro, N.C.

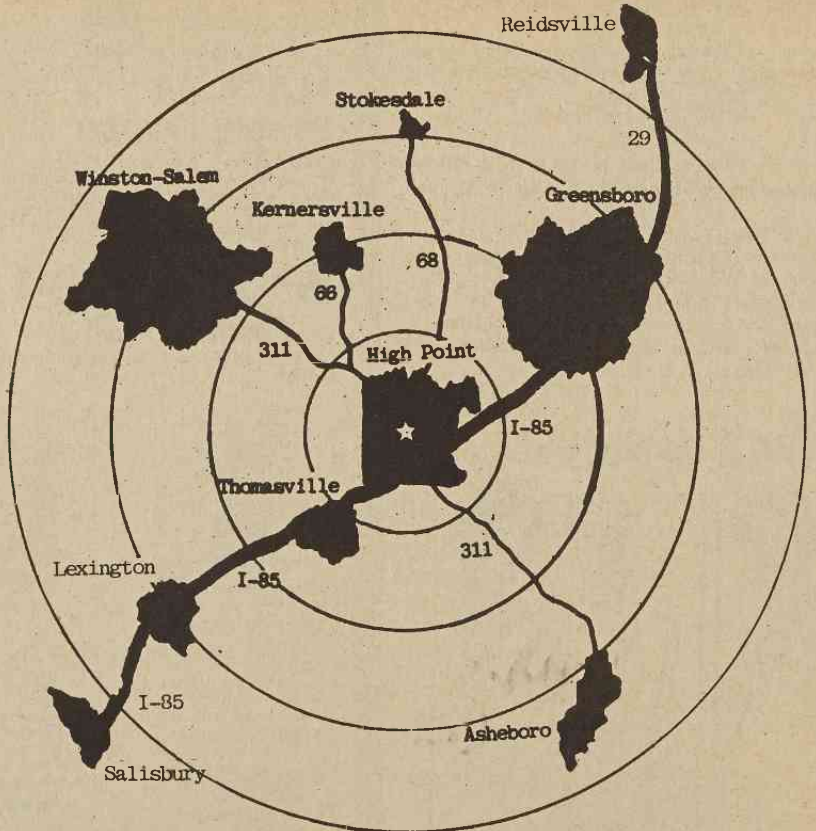
