lems is different in rural areas than in large urban areas.

"Rural areas do not need frequent fixed route service because there is insufficient demand to justify it," said Saltzman. "Rather, what is needed is a specialized transportation service that provides door-to-door service on a daily or weekly basis."

Saltzman also suggested that the committee give favorable consideration to proposed low non urbanized areas to use federal funds to pay to the operational expense of transit systems.

This would change the current regulations that allow only urban areas of over 50,000 to use federal funds for operating subsidies while those under 50,000 can only spend their funds on capital equipment such as buses and shelters.

The A&T Transportation Institute was funded five years ago under a grant from the

Urban Mass Transportation Administration of the Department of Transportation. The institute currently serves as a regional training and research center in the field of transportation.

The Senate subcommittee on transportation is chaired by Sen. Lloyd Bentsen, an announced candidate for President of the United States.

Awards was a high success, according to Rev. Frank Williams, in that it helped to promote the continuation of God's word through song. It was also a success in that it helped the groups to realize

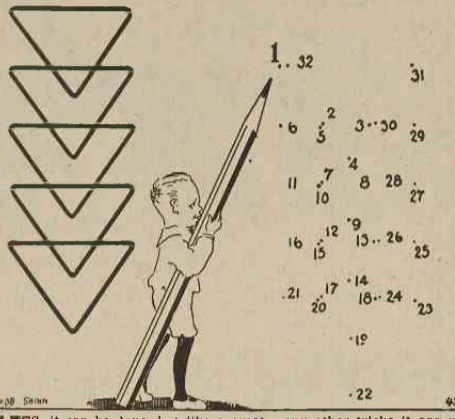
the importance of their singing and to give notice to gospel music that has been going unnoticed for so many years.
