runaways, child abuse and neglect cases, and the methods of diversions from the juvenile courts. various problems underlying delinquent behavior.

The trend toward community programs came about because of studies that showed local programs were as effective as institutional programs in rehabilitation, far less stigmatizing, and more humane to the child. Costs to the taxpayers drop drastically since keeping a child in a state institution has been estimated at approximately \$10,000 per year. But more important, local programs foster a sense of community responsibility for its own youths' problems.
