A Yes. The IRS will complete Form 1040 for you if your income, entered on line 15, is \$20,000 or less and consists only of wages and salaries, tips, dividends, interest, pensions and annuities. You must choose the standard deduction and file your return by April 15.

### WHAT IS YOUR QUESTION

Dying-Death-Estate Planning

A. J. WOLFE

DEAR MR. WOLFE:

I served in the Army from 1936 to 1939, with an honorable discharge. Am I eligible to get a grave plot in a nearby National Cemetery? I have heard there is a National Cemetery here in High Point or nearby. Is that true? If there is not a National Cemetery in High Point or nearby, what is the address of the nearest one?

DEAR J.M.:

In most cases a veteran who has an honorable discharge is entitled by law to burial in a military cemetery, or as we call them National cemeteries. From your information I see no reason why you would not be

The National cemeteries still open for burial in N.C. are in New Bern, Raleigh, Salisbury, and Wilmington. At this writing I do not know what space they have left, but I do know that National cemeteries are fast filling up. A recent survey showed that there is space for only one of every 20 eligible veterans. Of 117 federally owned cemeteries only 61 still have space available. In fact, there are 21 states without active cemeteries now. Veteran's families are finding that when death occurs often there are not active National cemeteries nearby, and of course the family would bear all transportation costs to ship elsewhere.

Because the National cemeteries are filling up, congress passed a law in August of 1973 saying that there would be an "additional allowance not exceeding \$150.00 for incurred expenses of interment or burial The featured speaker will plot..." when burial was not made in a National cemetery

Even if there should be an active Nat'l cemetery close to you now, there is no guarantee there will be space when you need it in the future...since these are used on a first come first serve basis.

For those who like statistics: In 1975 there were 37,000 burials in National Cemeteries. This is expected to reach 54,000 in 1978. Over the years there have been more than 1,300,000 burials in these federally operated cemeteries.

There is today 1 in 4 eligible to be buried in a Nat'l cemetery, which is about 50,000,000 people...but there are fewer than 2,500,000 unused burial sites.

1. Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held by the Council of the City of High Point, N.C. in the Council Chambers, 3rd floor, High Point Municipal Office Building, High Point, N.C. at 7:30 p.m., May 3rd, for the purpose of considering a project for which financial assistance is being sought from the Urban Mass Transportation Administration, pursuant to the Urban Mass Transportation Act of 1964. as amended, generally described as follows:

A. Description of Project:

[1] The project will purchase two air conditioned transit vehicles specially equipped to meet the needs of the elderly and handicapped.

[2] The project will purchase a parcel of land approximately 97,925 square feet immediately adjoining the site of the present transit facility, needed for parking as well as providing the space needed for a new maintenance facility.

[3] The project will provide operating assistance for expenses incurred during the 1976 fiscal year. [5] The estimated costs of the project are:

This project is in conformance with the comprehensive land use and transportation planning in this area. Copies will be send to the Piedmont Triad Council of Governments and the North Carolina State Department of Administration for their certification. E. Elderly and Handicapped:

The project will take into account the needs of the elderly and handicapped through the provision of special equipment and special routing which takes into account the residency of elderly and physically handicapped persons.

At the hearing, the Council of the City of High Point will afford an opportunity for interested persons or agencies to be heard with respect to the social, economic. and environmental aspects of the project. Interested persons may submit orally or in writing evidence and recommendations with respect to said project.

III. A copy of the primary application for a Federal Grant for the proposed project. together with an analysis of the environmental impacts of the project and the transit development plan for the area will be available for public inspection from April 12, 1976 at the High Point Municipal Office Building, 211 South Hamilton Street, High Point.
