

A grant of \$20,000 was received from the Low Income Housing Development Corporation of N.C. for the purpose of repairing and rehabilitating homes of low income home owners.

Loans up to \$5,000 with interest rates as low as one percent can be obtained for repairs through this program. To be eligible for a Farmers Home Administration loan the homeowner must occupy the house which is in need of repairs; reside outside a one-mile perimeter of the city of Statesville; have recent satisfactory credit history; have enough money coming in each month, including welfare payments, to repay the loan.

Additionally those homeowners residing inside the perimeter of Statesville who can provide materials can be served through this program.
