A&T Passing Sets New Marks

GREENSBORO -- With still four games remaining in the 1976 football season, Ellsworth Turner the North Carolina A&T quarterback and Dexter Feaster, his favorite receiver over the past three seasons, have broken single season passing and receiving records at the university.

Turner, the 1975 All-MEAC quarterback selection, has already passed for 1353 yards and 10 touchdowns this season. Turner set the yardage record in 1975 with 1349 yards.

KC Prepares For Homecoming

KNOXVILLE TENN. -- With less than a week before the 1976 Homecoming at Knoxville College, activity has shifted into high gear in preparation for the hundreds of students, friends, and alumni expected for the three days of activity scheduled for November 5-7, 1976.

The theme for this year's Homecoming is "KC ON A NEW EDUCATIONAL HORIZON." The emphasis will center around a renewal of spirit, dedication, and support to Knoxville College.

"We are expecting a large number of alumni for this year's observance," said J. Harvey Gillespie, coordinator for alumni affairs. "I've been in contact with the alumni across the U.S. and everyone is bubbling with enthusiasm in anticipation of a nostalgic return."

the long standing mark of Ron Francis of 457 yards in 1964.

"There are a lot of things that must be considered when a record like this is broken," Turner said. "The offensive line has given me outstanding protection all season allowing me the time to find my receivers."

"Also Feaster has improved tremendously as a receiver along with players like Bruce Black, Coy Holland, Allen Thomas, and Ron Scott. All of these guys have played a big part in my success."

"With a quarterback like Ellsworth all I have to do is get a little room and he will get the ball there," Feaster said. "I have been getting a

lot of double coverage but the development of Black, Ron Scott, and Coy Holland have forced the opposition to play more honestly."

This season Feaster and Turner have combined for 582 yards, the longest play being an 80 yard scoring pass against Florida A&M.

Turner is a junior and has another season remaining with the Aggies. Feaster, a senior from Charlotte, is looking forward to graduation and possibly a pro football career.
