Les Wright blocked a Smith kick and recovered in the Smith end zone for another Aggie score, while Peter Woods plunged two yards for the fina A. and T. touchdown in the fourth, quarter. Hubert Doub kicked five of the seven extra point tries.
Duke Brown plunged 6 yards for Smith's first touchdown in the third quarter and Ivory kicked the point, while Pass completed a 28 -yard scoring earial to Brown in the fourth period for Smith's second score

WOOL RESTRICTIONS
With only two exceptions OPB has. nifted all restrictions on use of raw wool. Finer grade of alpaca may not be used ex cept for military purposes, and only carpet wool and mohair may be used for floor coverings.
