

## Forty More Seniors Receive Diplomas At Bennett College

Forty-nine seniors will receive diplomas Monday, May 29, at 10 a.m. when Bennett College closes another academic year with commencement exercises highlighted by an address by Dr. Howard Thurman, dean of the chapel, Howard University.

The baccalaureate address will be delivered on Sunday May 28 at 4 p.m. by Dr. Matthew Simpson Davage, secretary of the department of educational institutions for Negroes of the Methodist Board of Education.

Dr. Thurman is a favorite speaker for local audiences and his address is eagerly anticipated since this will be his last in the

vicinity before he leaves to take over the pastorate of an inter-racial church in California.

He has spoken in more than 100 colleges and universities in all sections of the country and was commencement speaker last year at the Garrett Biblical Institute of Northwestern University.

Dr. Davage was formerly president of Clark University, Atlanta, where he raised \$1,500,000 for endowment, purchased a new site and erected an entirely new plant. He also served as president of Samuel Huston and Rust Colleges. He is a member of the board of trustees of several colleges and universities.

### BENNETT HOLDS FINAL VESPERS

Religion was suggested as the only foundation of peace by Dr. F. Howard Callahan of New York City, speaking at the final vesper service and installation of student officers of Bennett College Sunday.

It was his belief that only a peace built on the righteousness of God will last and he challenged religion to speak openly in public affairs.

An impressive ceremony installing student officers for next year was conducted by Miss Kathryn Davenport, president of the student senate. The incoming officers were presented by Miss Margaret Hill, president of the senior class. The ceremony included responses by the student leaders and student body.

Organization officers installed included: The Student Senate, Sunday School, Mid-Week Vespers, Woman's Society of Christian Service, Y.W.C.A., 'Little Theatre, Marshalls, Jr. and Senior Chorus, Residence Halls, Sociology Club, Orchestra, Library Staff, Book-Lovers Club, and Student Paper.

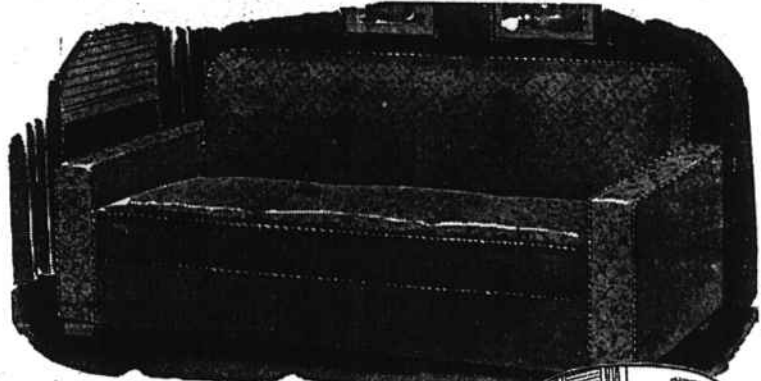

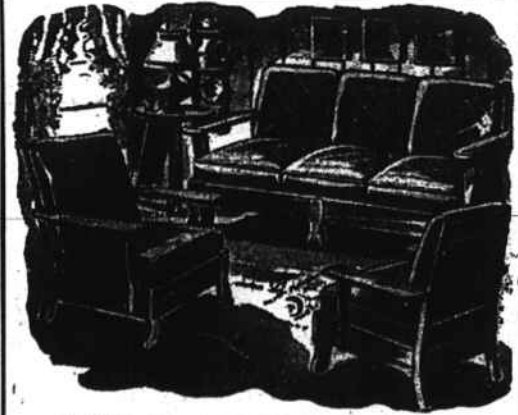

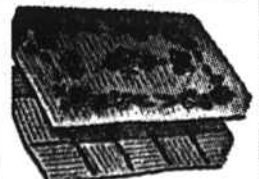
