Strawberry Happening

PINEAPPLE-STRAWBERRY BAVARIAN (Makes 6 to 8 servings)

| 1 envelope unflavored gelatine | 2 eggs, separated |
| 3/4 cup sugar | 2/3 cup (small can) undiluted velvitized evaporated milk |
| 1/4 teaspoon grated lemon peel | 1 tablespoon lemon juice |
| 1/8 teaspoon salt | Strawberry-Pineapple Sauce* |
| 1 1/4 cups unsweetened pineapple juice | |

Mix together gelatine, 1/2 cup sugar, lemon peel and salt in top of double boiler. Stir in pineapple juice and slightly beaten egg yolks. Cook, stirring constantly, over boiling water until sugar and gelatine dissolve, about 5 minutes. Chill until slightly thickened. Meanwhile, chill velvitized evaporated milk in refrigerator tray until soft ice crystals form around edges (10 to 15 minutes). Whip until stiff (about 1 minute). Add lemon juice and whip very stiff about 2 minutes. Beat egg whites until soft peaks form; gradually add remaining 1/4 cup sugar, beating until stiff but not dry. Fold whipped evaporated milk and egg whites into egg yolk mixture. Turn into 1 1/2 quart mold; chill until firm. Unmold. Garnish with strawberries, if desired, and serve with Strawberry-Pineapple Sauce*.

*Strawberry-Pineapple Sauce: (Makes about 2 1/2 cups): Mix 1 can (13 1/2 ounces) crushed pineapple, undrained, 2 teaspoons cornstarch and dash cinnamon; cook, stirring constantly until mixture boils 1 minute. Stir in 1/2 cup unsweetened pineapple juice; chill. Fold in 1 1/2 cups fresh strawberries, sliced.
