An indication that a new government spending orgy is likely in an effort to put a prop under collapsing recovery is evident again in the Capitol. It is reported that so-called "conservative" inner circle intimates of the administration have been won over by those who want more spending and that the relief spigots on the Treasury vaults will be turned on to greater flow. The "conservatives," however, deplore the use of the term "renewed spending," for they point out, the spending has never yet stopped.

The extent of this new spending is of course, dependent again on how much the government can borrow — since spending within its income cease to be a Federal fashion long ago.

The Treasury Department wants it known that it is not in the market for a "perfect ear of corn," regardless of the price, but especially at such figure as \$1,000,000 per ear. 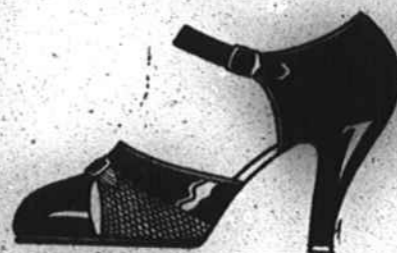

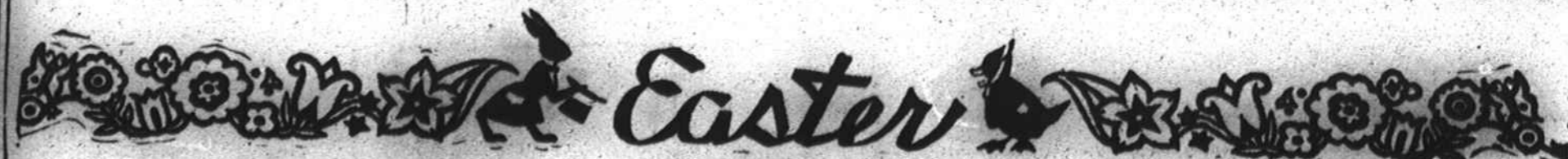
