Later he was auditor of Washington county.

In business, Mr. Jackson has been a Chevrolet dealer in Plymouth, manager of the western district with General Motors, and a traveling agent with the Universal Credit Company.

In May 1917, he married Miss Lela Hancock of New Bern, at which time he was serving in the Naval Reserve. He is a Master Mason, an Elk, and a member of the Kings Mountain Men's club. He is a member of Plymouth Christian Church.

"What do I like?" he asked. "Well trees, birds, animals — Mother Nature in her natural roughness. Then I like to do a bit of wood-carving, and anything hard. Anyone can do the easy thing, but there's no pleasure in it."

Mr. Jackson has obtained considerable mention with his many wood-carving of animals, men, and landscapes. One of his better pieces is a large plaque, naturally colored, showing a dog some six-inches high, with a background of trees and foliage.

"Monkey", his Boston terrier, is a boon companion, and is well known in Kings Mountain.
