

Dr. Shaw recommends either the 1-4-4-50 Bordeaux or the Cuprocide "54Y" spray for the control of strawberry leafspot and scorch. The first application should be made as soon as the new leaf growth has started in late February or early March. Applications should be repeated at 10 day intervals until a Iew days before the picking season begins.

The 4-4-50 Bordeaux mixture composed of four pounds of copper sulphate (blue stone) and 4 pounds of chemically hydrated lime to 50 gallons of water. From five to 10 gallons of spray wil be required for each application on one-tenth of an acre of an acre of strawberries, de-\*
