Chicks Need Heated Water During Winter

An egg is 70 percent water! That is a fact that C. F. Parrish, extension poultryman of N. C. State offege, constantly impresses upon poultry raisers in arging that they provide their flocks with plenty of ctean water in convenient fountains. yow, with the approach of winter 'arrish adds this suggestion:

Arrange for some heated water ountains for the flock to use when old weather arrives. Water conamption is greater when the chili s taken off, and the more water, a ien drinks, the more and the larger ier egg

The specialist also warns that rrafts thre openings in the back and ends of the laying house should be eliminated by closing such openings Winter is the time to make money rom egg production, when the supply is short, he says. The / a sur plus of eggs in the State only dur ag about six weeks in the spring. that leaves about 46 other weeks in the year that our homes and some markets are not amply supplied with quality eggs.

By selecting chicks of good breed ing, and by proper housing and feeding, the farm flock can be managed so as to produce eggs every month in the year. The great need is for summer and fall eggs. the flock is hatched early in the the fall. However, this can be done quite successfully by the use wet mash and lights on the laying
