Washington, Jan 21.—The office of production management backed up a plea for industry's co-operation in a census of equipment and resources by announcing today that it would investigate whether defense plants actually needed new machine tools they ordered.

Object of the investigation would be to spread the nation's limited machine tool supply as far as possible and make sure that no industry engaged in unnecessary retooling at government expense, officials explained.

A large number of Franklin county 4-H Club boys are making preparations to produce from 100 to 300 broilers this year, according to Edwin P. Barnes, assistant farm agent.

Jones County farmers using combines for the first time this past fall report much satisfaction from the machines, says John I. Eagles, assistant farm agent of the State College Extension Service.



BEFORE the time when people acquired individual names they were known simply by the symbol of their tribe or clan. This symbol was usually an animal, as for instance, the lion, and the people of that tribe which had adopted the lion as their symbol were known merely as Lion. They put the lion on clothing, bodies, cooking utensils, anything belonging to them much as we would write our name on our personal possessions. Each tribe had its own pole on which was carved their "totem" or "family token" by which they were known.
